Classification:	Skin Irrit. 2 - H315 Eye Dam. 1 - H318
Label Elements:	Danger
Hazard Statements:	H315 Causes skin irritation. H318 Causes serious eye damage. H400 Very toxic to aquatic life. H411 Toxic to aquatic life with long lasting effects.

SECTION 3: First Aid Measures

Inhalation:	Move to fresh air, keep warm and at rest. If symptoms persist seek medical advice.

Ingestion:	Wash out mouth with water and give plenty of water to drink. Do not induce vomiting. If patient feels unwell obtain medical attention
